

Year 1: Modelling Knowledge Mat

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Shape	To shape a model is to create a shape and fix it in place
Roll	To roll into a shape such as a ball or cylinder
Press	Using fingers or tools to force clay, dough or card down into shape
Smooth	Water can be applied to some clays to smooth the surface
Tie	Tying or binding paper or straws together to create shapes
3D	Three dimensional Length- width- depth

Materials for Modelling	
1	Clay -soft and can dry in air
2	Dough - soft and easily shaped
3	Straws - can be bundled and bent easily into desired shape
4	Paper/ card – can be used to secure models and sculptures or mixed with water to create a paste
