

# Year 1: Painting Knowledge Mat

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
<b>Stroke</b>	To move a hand/ brush with gentle pressure over (a surface), typically repeatedly
<b>Line</b>	Drawing is any image that consists of distinct straight or curved <b>lines</b> <b>Colouring within the lines</b>
<b>Pattern</b>	<b>Pattern</b> can be described as a repeating unit of shape or form
<b>Texture</b>	<b>texture</b> is the appearance of the surface quality of a work of <b>art</b>
<b>Form</b>	Like a <b>shape</b> , a <b>form</b> has length and width, but it also has depth.



Materials for Painting	
1	<b>Paint brush</b> – tool used to paint and create brush strokes
2	<b>Primary Colours</b> - colours which are not the result of mixing <b>red blue yellow</b>
3	<b>Crayons</b> – waxy tool to blend and create solid fills
4	<b>Pencils</b> – coloured pencils to blend together
5	<b>Chalk</b> – powdery tool used for thicker lines and blending
