

Year 3: Textiles Knowledge Mat

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Fabric	Fabric is cloth produced by weaving or knitting textile fibres
Thread	Thread is a long, thin strand of cotton, nylon, or other fibres used in sewing or weaving
Texture	Texture is the feel, appearance or feel of a surface
Weaving	Weaving is the craft or action of forming fabric by interlacing threads
Running stitch	Running stitch is a simple needlework stitch consisting of a line of small even stitches which run back and forth through the cloth without overlapping
Plaiting	To overlap three strands as with hair
Glue/join	Using glue to join fabrics together
Patchwork	Patchwork is small pieces of cloth in different designs, colours, or textures are sewn together

Materials for Textiles	
1	Thread – The material used to weave and sew
2	Binca – a gridded material with holes in to make sewing and weaving easier
3	Needle (soft ended) – to hold with your hands and direct the thread
