

Year 4: Textiles Knowledge Mat

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Fabric	Cloth produced by weaving or knitting textile fibres.
Running stitch	A simple needlework stitch consisting of a line of small even stitches which run back and forth through the cloth without overlapping.
Plaiting	A single length of hair, straw, rope, or other material made up of three or more interlaced strands
Dip dye	To immerse (a yarn or fabric) in a special solution in order to colour it. Gradients of colour or combinations of colour are typically used
Contrast	To compare obvious differences or similarities between works
Patchwork	Needlework in which small pieces of cloth in different designs, colours, or textures are sewn together.
Design	A plan or drawing produced to show the look and function or workings of a building, garment, or other object before it is made.

Materials for Textiles	
1	Fabric Dye- special dye used to colour fabrics
2	Dye bucket/container- where the material is dyed
3	Thread – typically from wool, this is the materials used to stitch
4	Needle- The tool which directs the thread and pierces materials
