

Year 5: Textiles Knowledge Mat

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
Cross stitch	A stitch formed of two stitches crossing each other
Back stitch	A method of sewing with overlapping stitches
Applique	Ornamental needlework in which pieces of fabric are sewn or stuck on to a larger piece to form a picture or pattern.
Embroidery	Decorate (cloth) by sewing patterns on it with thread
Plaiting	A single length of hair, straw, rope, or other material made up of three or more interlaced strands
Finger knitting	Finger knitting is a form of knitting where a knitted cord is created using only hands and fingers, instead of knitting needles or other traditional tools
Hanging	A decorative piece of fabric or curtain hung on the wall of a room or around a bed
Tactile	Of or connected with the sense of touch
Binca	The material used for cross stitching containing holes for stitches to cross through
Culture	The arts of human achievements regarded collectively. The ideas, customs, and social behaviour of a particular people or society

Materials for Textiles	
1	Needle- to control the thread and pierce through materials
2	Thread – the material used in stitching usually from wool
3	Binca – the material with hole for cross stitch
4	Fingers – as a hold for the knitting process (see below)
